General Administration (SPF&MC) Department - Relieving of certain employees who are local to Telangana, opted to Telangana, but allotted to Andhra Pradesh - Request of Government of Telangana for their relief - Orders-Issued.

The Government of Telangana in the reference 1st read above, conveyed consent for taking back (122) Telangana native employees, working in the office of the HoDs/AP Secretariat, who are allotted to Andhra Pradesh as against their options for Telangana at the time of bifurcation of the State.

2. Accordingly, orders were issued, vide the reference 2nd read above, permitting all the HoDs to relieve the employees in the post category specified by the Government of Telangana in the list of **(122)** employees.

3. Thereafter, the Government of Telangana was addressed vide the letters in the reference 3rd read above, requesting their consent for Interstate transfer of 23 employees amongst the list of above (122) employees, who had been promoted to higher posts from the category in which they joined in the Andhra Pradesh cadre after bifurcation.

4. In representation 4th read above, the Chairman, APJAC Amaravati, while enclosing the representations of certain employees, has requested to forward the same to the Government of Telangana to consider their request (i) to join in the identical cadre in which they were originally allotted to Andhra Pradesh during the

State bifurcation by the Kamalanadhan Committee (ii) by giving pay protection as laid down in FR 22-B(1) & other relevant Government norms/rules applicable to Inter State Transfers ensuring continuity of their financial benefits.

5. In the reference 5th read above, while enclosing the representations of the said employees, the Government of Telangana were requested to take necessary action as there is no objection on the part of the AP on the request made by the employees.

6. In response to the above letter, the Government of Telangana in the letter 6th read above, while enclosing a Proforma of Undertaking, requested to relieve the ministerial service category employees, who are local to Telangana & willing to join in Telangana **subject to obtaining suitable undertaking/declaration** that they will join in Telangana in the category of post held by them as on the date of final allocation of State cadres and take last rank in the respective cadres already working in Telangana.

7. In the representation 7th read above, the Chairman, APJAC, Amaravati has requested to consider & issue Relief Orders to all affected employees to facilitate their immediate transfer/repatriation to Telangana State to join in the identical cadre in which they were originally allotted to Andhra Pradesh and ensure their financial interests are secured as a final act of humanitarian relief.

8. The Government, after careful examination, have decided to accept the request of Government of Telangana & hereby order to relieve the ministerial service category employees, local to Telangana, as mentioned in the Annexure-I to this order, who are willing to join in Telangana, subject to obtaining the Undertaking/Declaration in the proforma furnished by Government of Telangana enclosed as Annexure - II to this order, that they will join in Telangana in the category of post held by them as on the date of final allocation of State cadres and take last rank in the respective cadres already working in Telangana.

9. The Secretariat Departments noted in the address entry shall issue suitable instructions to the concerned HoDs under their administrative control to relieve the employees mentioned in the Annexure-I to this order, **who are willing to submit undertaking in the proforma furnished by Government of Telangana and are willing to join in Telangana in the category of posts held by them as on the date of final allocation of State cadres and take last rank in the respective cadres already working in Telangana.** The undertaking in the prescribed proforma be obtained in duplicate and should be digitized. One copy be retained in with them & the other should be enclosed to the relieving orders issued to the employees.
